

PRIVACY NOTICE

At Pride Home Care Ltd, we are committed to protecting the privacy and personal data of our clients, their relatives and friends, staff, volunteers, healthcare professionals and visitors to our website. This Privacy Notice explains how we collect, use, share, and protect personal data in accordance with applicable data protection legislation, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), as laid out under Article 6 (1) of the GDPR.

- 1. **Data Controller:** Managing Director, Daniel Burcham is the Data Controller responsible for the processing of personal data. If you have any questions or concerns regarding the processing of your personal data, you can contact us using the details provided at the end of this Privacy Notice.
- 2. **Types of Personal Data Collected:** We may collect and process the following types of personal data:
- Clients: Name, address, contact details, medical history, care requirements, and other necessary information for providing homecare services.
- Staff and Volunteers: Name, address, contact details, employment/volunteer history, qualifications, and other relevant information for employment or volunteering purposes.
- Website Visitors: IP address, browser information, and other analytics data collected through cookies (refer to our Cookie Policy for more information).
- 3. **Purpose and Legal Basis for Processing**: We process personal data for the following purposes and on the following legal bases:
- Providing Homecare Services: We process client data to deliver personalized care services based on the individual's care requirements. The legal basis for this processing is the performance of a contract.
- Employment and Volunteer Management: We process staff and volunteer data for recruitment, employment, training, and support purposes. The legal basis for this processing is the necessity for the performance of a contract and compliance with legal obligations.
- Website Improvement: We collect analytics data to improve our website and enhance the user experience. The legal basis for this processing is our legitimate interests in optimizing our website's functionality.
- 4. **Sharing Personal Data:** We may share personal data with the following parties for the purposes described above:
- Third-party service providers: We may engage trusted third-party service providers who process personal data on our behalf, such as IT support, payment processors, and analytics providers.
- Regulatory authorities: We may disclose personal data to comply with legal obligations or respond to lawful requests from regulatory authorities.
- Care professionals: We may share relevant personal data with healthcare professionals involved in providing homecare services.
- 5. **Data Retention:** We will retain personal data for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Notice and comply with legal requirements. We will securely dispose of personal data when it is no longer needed.
